- Developed the booklet to list 2020 CDG information

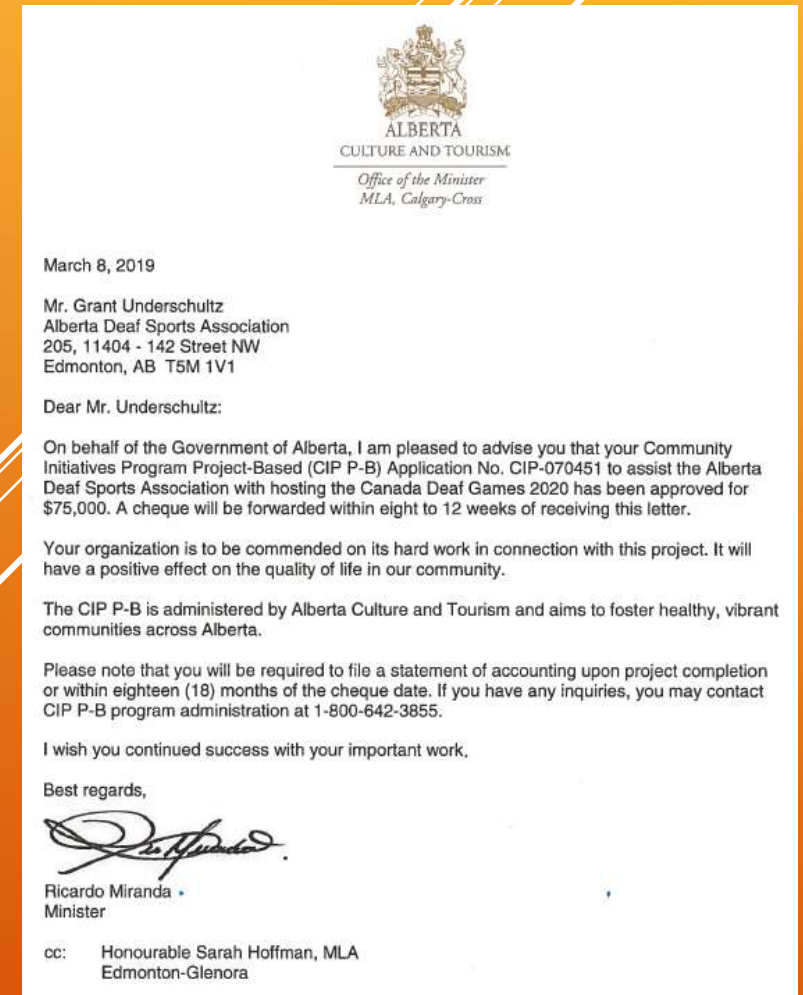

- Submit a registration form for each **individual** athlete on your team. Enter a note at the bottom of the form providing all members on the team. This is important for our tracking records and for individual name badges that will be provided which include athletes name and team sport.
- Responsibility of PDSAs (BCDSF, ADSA, SDSA, MDSA, ODSA, ASSQ): To submit all athletes registration forms including **athlete** information, **PDSA Coaches**, **PDSA Chef de Missions**, and **PDSA Chaperones**.

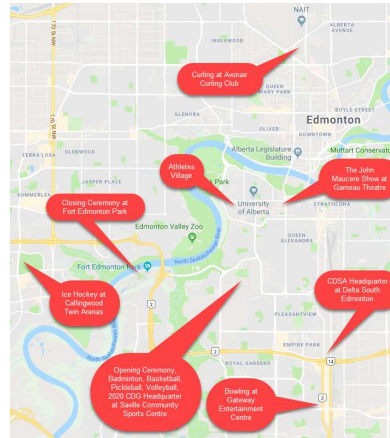
Important Notes:

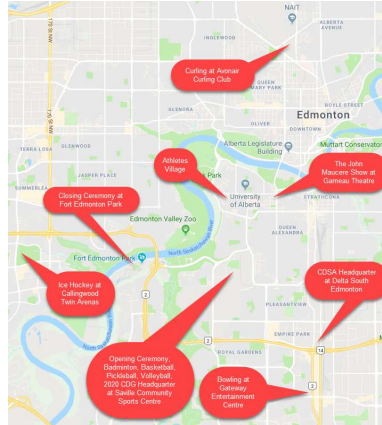

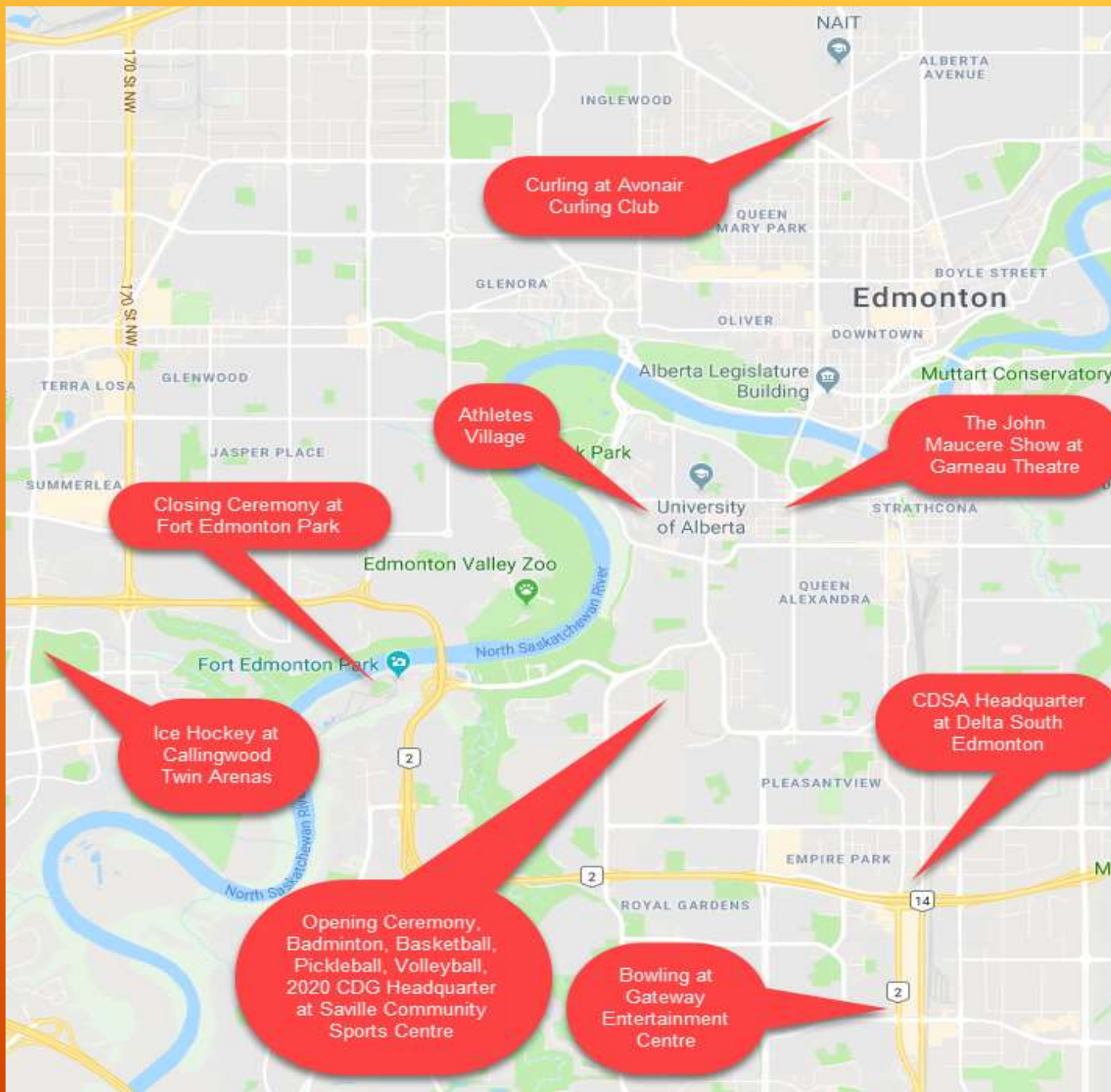

ELIGIBILITY:



Hearing Loss Participation in the competition is restricted to athletes that are Deaf and/or hard of hearing.

To the contrary of the International Committee of Sports for the Deaf (ICSD) that restricts participation for athletes with a hearing loss of at least 55 decibels, we encourage all participants that are Deaf and/or hard of hearing involved in the Deaf community to participate at the CDG.

We leave the responsibility to PDSAs to explain to their participants if they are eligible or not of events sanctioned by the ICSD.
